## Form 990 Not for Profit Tax Return Course Description:

The object of this course is to train both new and experienced preparers how to navigate the Form 990, recognize common issues when filing Form 990, describe basic not-for-profit issues, explain unrelated business income and its impact to not-for-profit entities, identify common mistakes made during Form 990 preparation, and determine proper reporting requirements for unique situations for not-for-profits.
